### **How to enter:**

To enter the contest, you must be 16 or younger. Send an email to [education@miningmuseum.org](mailto:education@miningmuseum.org). You may also mail your photographs along with the entry form to 155 Museum Way, PO Box 33, Butte, MT 59703. By submitting pictures, you agree to grant unconditional copyright release to the World Museum of Mining for use as we see fit.

No persons shall be included in the photographs. The photographs should include a historical landmark/place/building in or around Butte, MT or a depiction of what mining means to you. The historical and mining interpretation is up to the youth. The World Museum of Mining is looking to preserve the images and reminders of Butte from a child's eye as well as the impact mining has on our daily lives.

High-quality scans of non-digital photographs are acceptable. Digital photographs should be taken at the highest resolution possible and must be in a .jpeg or .jpg. Complete a separate form for each photo submitted.
